SPOTLIGHT: Haiti by the Numbers

When disaster strikes, we often attempt to quantify it and view chaos through the order of numbers. We don't always succeed. After Chile's 8.8-magnitude earthquake February 27, media called it 6 times, 30 times, 50 times, 300 times, 500 times, 700 times, and 1,000 times larger than Haiti's 7.0 quake. There were other efforts as well. (The answer: 512 times larger.) But Chile saw far fewer casualties than Haiti—and charitable giving is likely to be much lower. Death tolls alone don't draw us. Burma's Cyclone Nargis in 2008 killed about 140,000, but, largely because of the country's restrictive junta, international relief donations totaled only \$310 million. Donations to Haiti surpassed that in nine days.


