

SPOTLIGHT: Getting Obama's Faith Wrong

An August Pew Forum report found that nearly one in five Americans thinks President Obama is a Muslim. Even more surprising: 60 percent of Americans who think he's Muslim say they learned it from the media. A quarter of those who think he's Muslim say Obama talks about his faith too much. The belief correlates strongly with political opposition, but it's not only those who dislike Obama who have changed: less than half of Democrats and African Americans now say he's a Christian. By the way, Pew's survey happened before Obama spoke about the prospect of an Islamic center near the World Trade Center site. A Time poll taken after his remarks, with slightly different wording than Pew's, found that 24 percent of Americans think Obama is a Muslim.
