Lucas Suriano of Prison Alliance, a global prison ministry, believes the global Church is disconnected.

"There are small fires here and there. If you put together the small fires, it's a huge burst. That is what Christianity Today will accomplish over time—you're connecting those small fires."

Lucas saw this firsthand. In El Salvador, 1 in 56 people are in jail. Tough new laws have led to mass incarcerations, and ministers now struggle for access. Never has the need for the gospel in El Salvador been so great, and access so limited.

But when CT illuminated this crisis, the Church responded.

"The *Christianity Today* article allowed [local pastor] Mario to start a Prison Alliance discipleship program in the Apateos Prison," Lucas said. "We have purchased 300 hygiene kits for our first 300 female students already. Mario will visit this first prison weekly, with the support of the local authorities."

When the Church unites, the kingdom expands. This is the power of connecting the small fires. This is The Global Initiative.
